

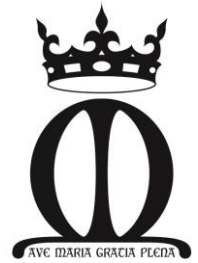

RESTORATION OF THE THOMAS LEWIS ORGAN

After a period of repair and restoration, the Cathedral's Organ is due to be re-installed this summer!

This has to be done even if your wedding is taking place abroad, or your intended lives abroad. If you have been a resident in England for six months or more and regularly attend Mass at St Marie's, your forms and paperwork will need to be completed here before being forwarded to the parish where the marriage will take place. If you have any queries do speak to one of the priests as soon as possible.
