

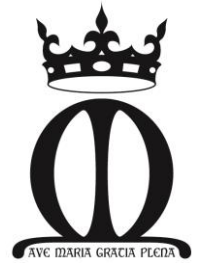

After a period of repair and restoration, the Cathedral's Organ is due to be re-installed this summer! But we need your help with fundraising in order to cover the costs of the restoration.
