**VISITATION OF THE NATIONAL PILGRIM STATUE
AND THE RELICS OF Ss JACINTA & FRANCISCO**

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, and Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco, are travelling around the country from May to October 2017, and will be coming to St Marie's Cathedral from 12th–13th August.

The weekend will include Mass celebrated by Bishop Ralph Heskett, C.Ss.R., at 12.30pm on the Saturday, an Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, enthronement and crowning of the National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, veneration of the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco, and talks on Fatima topics, as well as investiture in the Brown Scapular.
