## ADOREMUS—NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS 2018 Friday 7th–Sunday 9th September, in Liverpool

Eucharistic Congresses are gatherings of the faithful, both clergy and lay, to promote an awareness of the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Church. The last International Eucharistic Congress in England was held all the way back in 1908, so this is an event not to be missed!

There are three separate events over the course of the weekend: the Symposium Day on Friday 7th September (£40), the Eucharistic Congress Day on Saturday 8th September (£40, plus £15 coach transport if needed), and the Pilgrimage Day on Sunday 9th September (free).
