Next Sunday there will be a second collection for **Peter's Pence**.

This fund provides the Holy Father with the financial means to respond to those who are suffering as a result of war, oppression, natural disaster, and disease.

We are still some way short of the weekly Sunday collection target of £1500 to support two Priests. Another 57p per person on top of last Sunday's collection is needed to reach this target.
