The figures for last Sunday's collections will be printed in next week's bulletin.

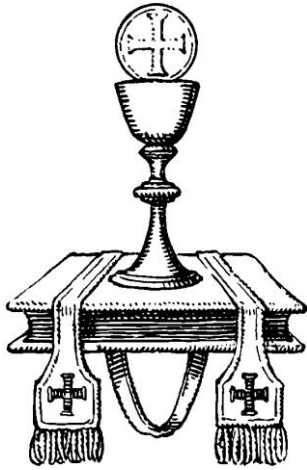
This Sunday there will be a second collection for the **Apostleship of the Sea**.
