First Holy Communion and Confirmation Programmes 2018/19

The new First Holy Communion and Confirmation programmes will begin shortly.

For the First Holy Communion programme: Children who are in Year 3 and upwards are eligible to take part in this year's programme. Registrations will be held on Friday 21st September and Tuesday 2nd October, at 6.30pm in Houlden Hall. The first session of the programme will be on Sunday 7th October.

For the Confirmation programme: Children who are in Year 8 and upwards are eligible to take part. Registration will be held on Tuesday 25th September, at 6.30pm in Houlden Hall. The first session of the Confirmation programme will be on Sunday 30th September.

If you would like your child/young person to take part in either programme, they will need to be registered. Please go to the Cloister after Sunday Mass, and sign up to one of the registration days.
