## **DOWRY TOUR OF OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM**

**Thursday 22nd–Saturday 24th November**

The Slipper Chapel statue of Our Lady of Walsingham will be visiting St Marie's Cathedral next month, and everyone is warmly invited! The tour will include a small shrine to Our Lady of Walsingham, the Slipper Chapel statue, plus a Dowry exhibition which details the life of the Catholic Church in England over the last 1,000 years, with a particular focus on the Shrine at Walsingham.

The tour will start with Vespers (Evening Prayer) at 5.15pm and Mass at 5.30pm on Thursday 22nd November, and will continue until the closing Mass at 12.30pm on Saturday 24th November. There will be talks on the Thursday and Friday evenings about the Dowry of Mary, as well as extra opportunities to pray the Rosary and to adore the Blessed Sacrament.
