Slovak Mass (Svätá Omša v slovenčine): the next Slovak Mass is this Sunday (14th April), 4.30pm at St Bede's in Rotherham (Station Rd, S60 1HF). There will also be a Good Friday liturgy in Slovak on 19th April, 6.00pm at St Catherine's (Burngreave Rd, S3 9DN), and a Slovak Mass for Easter Sunday on 21st April, 11.00am, also at St Catherine's.

The Mass of Chrism: Everyone is welcome to come to the Mass of Chrism, which starts at 11.00am in the Cathedral on Holy Wednesday (17th April).

Blessing of Easter Breakfast Food—Holy Saturday (20th April): It is the tradition in some Eastern European countries to begin the celebration of Easter Day with a family or communal breakfast. On Holy Saturday, food including bread, meat products and boiled painted eggs, can brought in baskets to be blessed before being shared in the home on Easter morning. These blessings will be performed at the Cathedral between 11.30am and 12.30pm (in Polish) and 12.30-1.00pm (in Slovak) on Holy Saturday. Everyone is welcome to bring a basket!

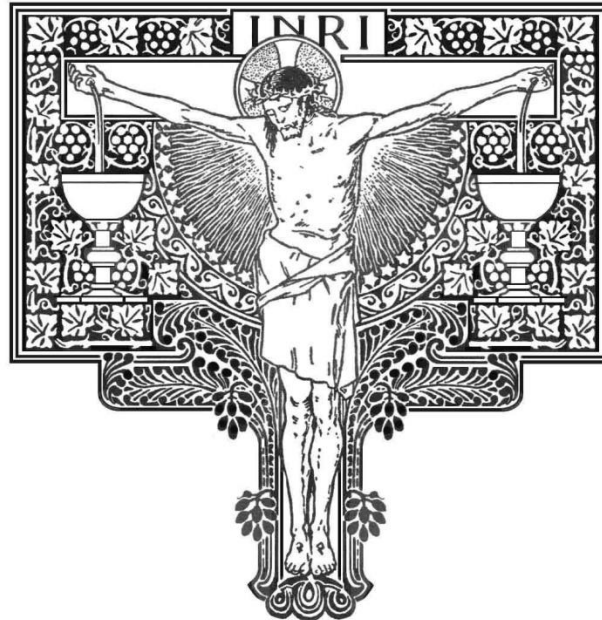
