Mass intentions: a reminder that any Mass intentions (along with stipends) can be dropped off at Cathedral House during office hours, posted through the letterbox, or left with a Priest after Mass.

Last year, it was established that we needed to hit a weekly Sunday collection target of £1500 in order to support two priests and continue with the full range of weekend Masses currently on offer. Every penny helps, so please give what you can. And if you are a UK Taxpayer, please consider setting up a regular method of donating, so that the Cathedral can claim an extra 25p in every pound. (This is at no extra cost to you, via the Government's GiftAid scheme).
