


Saints Peter & Paul

Solemnity: Saints Peter & Paul.

Today, we celebrate Saints Peter and Paul, who are considered to be the early leaders of the Church after Jesus died. Saint Peter – also known as Simon Peter – was one of the 12 apostles, as you know. In today's Gospel, we are reminded how Jesus tasked him, three times, with the job of feeding and looking after Jesus' sheep. Peter went on to become the first Pope of Rome, before being put to death by the Emperor Nero.

Saint Paul, on the other hand, didn't know Jesus until *after* Jesus had died, when he had a miraculous conversion on the road to Damascus. Before that happened, Paul (or Saul, as he was also known) had been very cruel towards the early Christians. God chose Paul to spread the good news about Jesus to the people who did not know God. He was very good at that, and he was also eventually put to death in Rome.

Many miracles were associated with Peter and Paul during their lifetimes, and lots of people became believers in Jesus because of them. But Peter and Paul didn't take the credit for that; both of them understood that these miracles were only possible because of Jesus. At each point, they performed *in the name of Jesus Christ*, and always gave thanks to God for his help.

Paul explained it this way, "I no longer live, but Christ lives in me". When we invite Jesus to come and live in us too, miracles can also happen!


