Loving God, Loving Each Other

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Year A.

Rules are very important, aren't they? Whether you are at school, at work, or play there are rules that you are expected to follow. The people in Jesus' day had to follow rules too. God gave Moses 10 rules to follow, which Moses wrote on tablets of stone. We call them the Ten Commandments. But the Jews at that time actually had a total of 613 laws, 248 'dos' and 365 'don'ts' - wow! Can you imagine trying to remember all of those?

In today's Gospel, we hear how a lawyer one day asked Jesus, "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment?" Now listen to what Jesus had to say.

Jesus answered him, "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind,' this is the greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets." In other words, Jesus was saying that if we could keep these two commandments, we would not have any trouble keeping the others.

It isn't easy to keep the commandments, is it? We need God's help each and every day. Let's pray and ask him to help us to love as he has commanded us.



