Sacrament of Confession: Confessions will be heard in St Joseph's Chapel on Tuesday 29th–Thursday 31st December and Saturday 2nd January, from 11.30–12.15pm. From Monday 4th January, the days and times for Confessions will return to normal (Mon–Sat, 11.30am–12.15pm).

Office opening hours: please note that the Cathedral office will be closed until Monday 4th January.

Journey in Faith will take a break over the Christmas period, and the next session will be on Tuesday 12th January, online via Microsoft Teams, starting at 7.30pm.

Mass Booking System: Due to the current laws and guidelines in place, it is necessary for everyone to book a place at the Saturday Vigil and all Sunday Masses at St Marie's Cathedral. Please text the appropriate Mass code, followed by a space and then the number of people you are booking for, to **07476 558810**. The Mass codes are as follows:

Mass Time	Code
Saturday, 5.30pm	Sat1730
Sunday, 8.00am	Sun0800
Sunday, 9.30am	Sun0930

Mass Time	Code
Sunday, 11.00am	Sun1100
Sunday, 12.30pm	Sun1230
Sunday, 6.30pm	Sun1830

So, to give an example, if you wanted to book three places at the 9.30am Sunday Mass, you would text **Sun0930 3** to 07476 558810, and so on.

Anyone unable to use the text-based system can ring the Cathedral Office (0114 272 2522) to book. If you are unable to attend the Mass you have booked places for, please let us know by contacting the Cathedral Office during office hours or, outside of office hours, the PPC (PPC@stmariecathedral.org). Thank you.

A note about data protection (GDPR): By texting us in this way, you consent to the use of your number for the purposes of the booking system. The phone numbers are not linked in any way to names and addresses, and will be kept for 21 days before being destroyed.

Confirmation Programme 2021: Registration for this year's Confirmation programme will be held in the Cathedral on Saturday 16th January, at 10.30am. Children who are in **Year 8 and upwards** are eligible to take part. The course itself will be held on Mondays, beginning on 18th January, from 6.00-7.00pm on-line via Zoom.

First Holy Communion Programme 2021: This year's First Holy Communion programme will start on Tuesday 26th January, at 6.00pm on-line via Zoom. Children who are in **Year 3 and upwards** are eligible to take part. To register your child for the course, please pick up an application form after Mass and return it to the Cathedral office or one of the Priests before the first session.

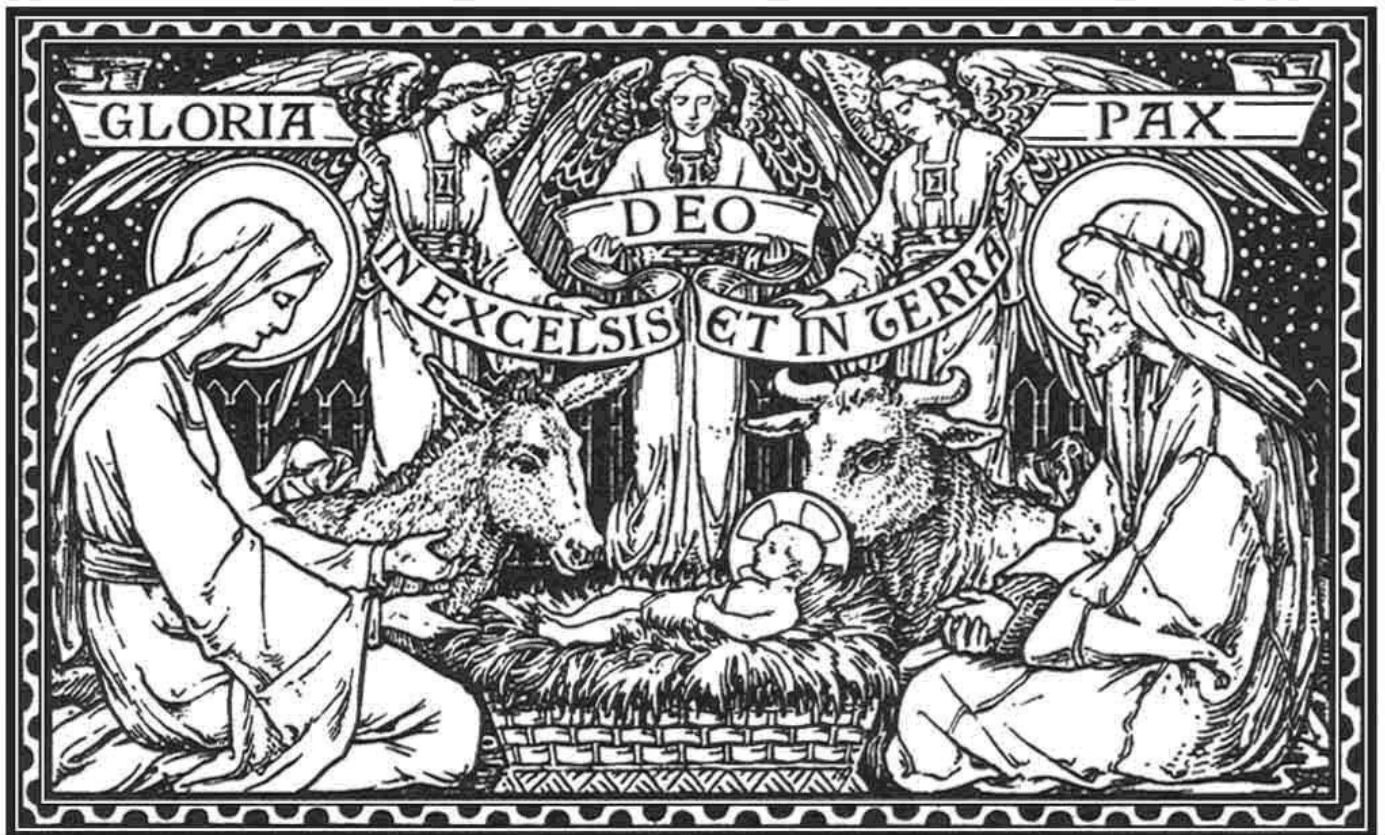
The Cathedral will open at 11.30pm on Thursday 31st December in preparation for Mass at midnight to usher in the New Year. All welcome!
