### Jesus Ministers In Galilee

#### ***Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Year B.***

I've got a really useful 'smart phone'. Not only can I call and text on it, but I can do emails, 'surf the net', play games, listen to music...It even turns into a torch! But if it's not charged up, it can't do any of those things. People are like that too - they also need to recharge their batteries. In today's Gospel, we get to hear about a typical day in the life of Jesus, and what he did to 'recharge'.

After leaving the synagogue on the Sabbath day, Jesus and some of his disciples went to the home of Simon and Andrew. When they arrived, Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever. When Jesus heard about it, he went to her, took her by the hand and helped her up. All at once, the fever left her and she began to prepare a meal for everyone. That evening, crowds of sick people gathered around the house, and Jesus cured many of them. Jesus must have felt exhausted!

But the next morning, Jesus could not be found at first. You see, Jesus had got up early before sunrise and had gone to find a quiet place to pray. Jesus knew that it was important for him to spend time each day talking to his Father if he was going to have the spiritual strength to do what his Father had sent him to do. By the time Simon and the others had found him, Jesus had recharged his batteries and was ready to go. He said to them, "Let's go to other towns and villages so that I can preach to them too. That's what I came to do." So that is what they did.

Prayer can help us to recharge our spiritual batteries too! So give it a try, and see what difference it can make for you...

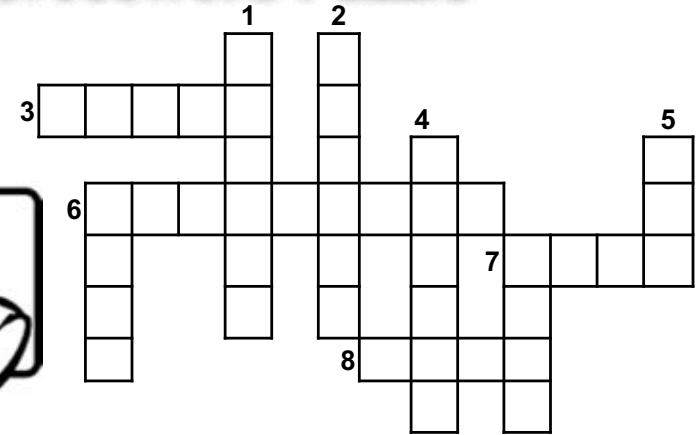
