Mass Booking System: Due to the current laws and guidelines in place, it is necessary for everyone to book a place at the Saturday Vigil and all Sunday Masses at St Marie's Cathedral. Please text the appropriate Mass code, followed by a space and then the number of people you are booking for, to **07476 558810**. So, to give an example, if you wanted to book three places at the 9.30am Sunday Mass, you would text **Sun0930 3** to 07476 558810, and so on.

The 11.00am Mass will be open to the public again, as of Palm Sunday (28th March).

Anyone unable to use the text-based system can ring the Cathedral Office (0114 272 2522) to book. If you are unable to attend the Mass you have booked places for, please let us know by contacting the Cathedral Office during office hours or, outside of office hours, the PPC (PPC@stmariecathedral.org). Thank you.

A note about data protection (GDPR): By texting us in this way, you consent to the use of your number for the purposes of the booking system. The phone numbers are not linked in any way to names and addresses, and will be kept for 21 days before being destroyed.

Join Us in a Novena Of Prayer Divine to The Divine Mercy—starts on Good Friday: Divine Mercy Sunday is on the 2nd Sunday of Easter, and is a time where we are all encouraged to say a Novena of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, starting on Good Friday. (A Novena simply means 9 days of prayer.) The Divine Mercy Chaplet was given to St Faustina by Jesus Christ himself, and is a beautiful prayer using a set of rosary beads. 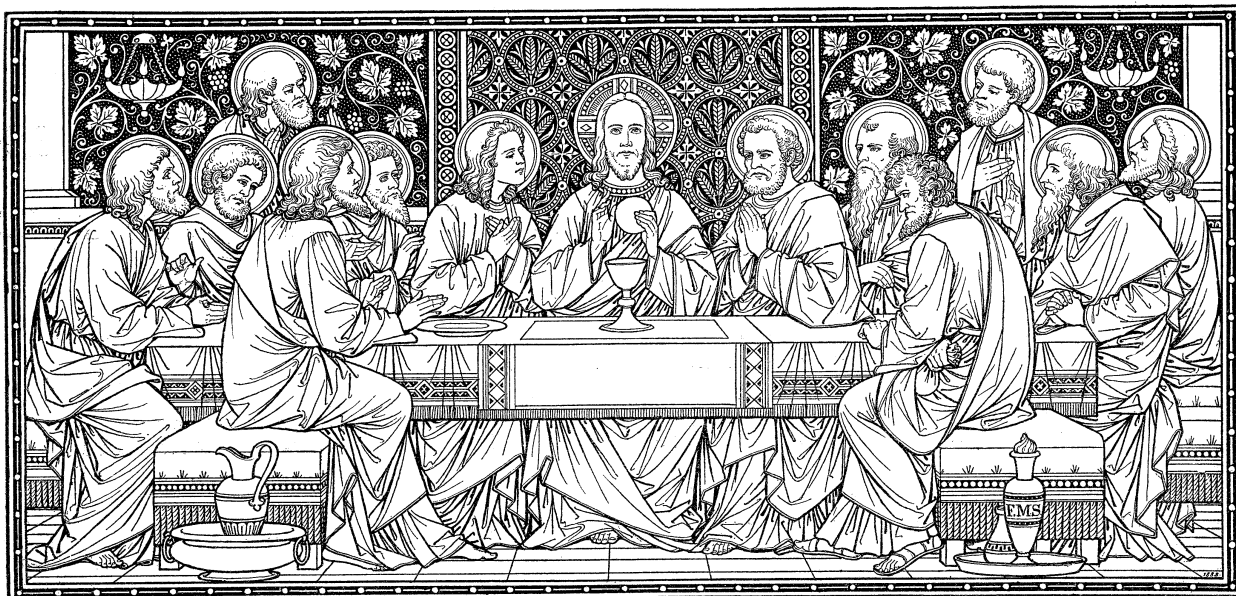
