

Jesus Loves Us ALL!

Sixth Sunday of Easter. Year B.

Do you like sweets and chocolates? What's your favourite kind? We went to a shop last weekend, and all the children were offered a 'dip' in a big orange bucket full of sweets. With so many to choose from, my children found it difficult to make a decision. And I found myself wondering whether some sweets were more popular than others, and what they might be left with at the end of the day. If I were to stick around, I doubt there would be any left – I love them all!

In today's Gospel, we hear how Jesus told his disciples to "love one another, as I have loved you". But that's not always easy, is it? Sometimes we treat people the same way as we may treat sweets. When children play games, some children are always the last to be chosen. Maybe it is because they are just a little bit different to us. Maybe they are bigger, maybe they are smaller, maybe their skin is a different colour, or their hair is different. Whatever the reason might be, the other children just won't choose them first.

Have you ever been the one that wasn't chosen? It isn't a very good feeling, is it? We all need to remember that Jesus loves ALL the children and He said, "Love each other as I have loved you." So if you see someone being left out, remember what Jesus told us – and try to help them feel included and loved. And if you are ever the one that is left out, don't worry – I can promise you that Jesus loves you just as much as He loves the other children... He loves us ALL!


"This is what I command you to do: love each other in the same way as I have loved you."
