**Read/Listen to the WHOLE Bible, in a Year:** Have you ever managed to read the whole Holy Bible? Ever thought it might even be possible for you? The *Bible in a Year* podcast, by Fr Mike Schmitz, will walk you through the entire Catholic Bible in 365 days, providing commentary, reflection and prayer along the way. It uses a ground-breaking approach to understanding salvation history (developed by renowned Catholic Bible teacher Jeff Cavins), which uses the 14 narrative books that tell the story of Scripture from beginning to end. The remaining “supplemental books” of the Bible are then contextualized within the storyline of the 14 narrative books. Each day's podcast is around 20 mins in length, and can easily be fitted into your day. The podcast is available on all the major apps, and on YouTube: just search “Bible in a Year Fr Mike” and it will come up.

**Refreshments after the 10.30am Sunday Mass:** Every Sunday after the 10.30am Mass, there is an opportunity to get together with other parishioners over a cup of coffee or tea.
