(Please note there is a charge for this service which is deducted from donations before they are paid to the parish). Donations made this way can be gift aided.
- Setting up a standing order is a very good way to ensure that weekly contributions are made regularly, they are easy to set up and forms are available from [office@stmariecathedral.org](mailto:office@stmariecathedral.org) to complete and return if you would like to do this.
- If you are confident with online banking, it is possible to set up a standing order from your bank account yourself. The parish bank details, if you wish to do this, are:

- If you are doing more of your shopping online, please consider using “Easy Fundraising” (<https://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/>). Whatever transactions you do online, using this website allows charities to receive donations from the companies you use. Sign into Easy fundraising, select “Cathedral Church of St Marie – Sheffield” as the charity and then choose the retailer you want to buy from. They will then pay a percentage of the value of your shop to St Marie's. It is really that simple and that worthwhile.
