**Supporting the Homeless and Vulnerable in Sheffield—Top Tip #1:** Homelessness is a very complex issue, and in July we had two local experts to come and talk to us about the issue. Sheffield has some truly fantastic, multi-agency teams working to support each and every individual who is on the streets of our City. In 2021 these teams worked with over 800 clients, and had over 500 positive outcomes. If you would like to do something to help, a smile and a brief exchange can make the world of difference to someone on the street. But please appreciate that not everyone will want to engage or talk, so do a quick assessment, based on body language, location and the activity around someone, before you step into their personal space.

**Funeral Arrangements for Fr Denis Norman:** The body of Fr Denis will be brought to the parish of St Joseph & St Teresa at Woodlands on the evening of Wednesday 10th August, where a Vigil Mass will be celebrated at 6.00pm.
