**Do you come to the 12.30pm Mass? Please support Ana and Shenade:** Ana and Shenade have been volunteering as Mass Stewards for the Sunday 12.30pm Mass for the past 2 years. At the end of August, Shenade will be leaving Sheffield to start a new chapter in her career, and Ana will be the only remaining Steward. Stewards are there to give a warm welcome to people, answer questions, and to do a range of little jobs to help each Mass run smoothly. If you are not ready to volunteer as a Steward, please consider just offering your help at one Mass instead—no experience necessary! Just speak to Ana and Shenade directly, and they will suggest little ways you can help. Thank you.

**Supporting the Homeless and Vulnerable in Sheffield—Top Tip #2:** People can be on the streets for a variety of different reasons, and in July we had two local experts to come and talk to us about the issue. Did you know that more than 85% of people who become street homeless have experienced childhood traumas or are suffering with PTSD? That is why Sheffield's multi-agency teams work very closely with each other to agree carefully co-ordinated action plans for every individual on our streets. When talking to someone on the streets, work with whatever they choose to tell you. Don't ask personal questions – be guided by them – and don't talk about yourself either. Instead, seek to show a genuine interest in them, and to make them the object of your attention for a few minutes.

**For Catholic in Health and Social Care—New Resources from the Anscombe Bioethics Centre:** The Anscombe Bioethics Centre is an organisation which does research on behalf of our Bishops as well as education for the Catholic community on moral matters in medicine.
