**Bible in a Year, Days 22-28—Journey with God, Joseph and his brothers:** On Days 22-26, we journey with Joseph, where we see how the faithfulness of Joseph in the Old Testament foreshadows the faithfulness of St Joseph (the husband of Mary) in the New Testament. On Day 27, we are then introduced to a whole new time period—Egypt & Exodus—about 400+ years after Jacob and Joseph, where we meet Moses. The 'Bible in a Year' podcast, with Fr Mike Schmitz, uses a ground-breaking approach developed by renowned Catholic Bible teacher Jeff Cavins, to tell the 'mega-story' of our Salvation History. Each day's podcast is around 20 mins in length, can easily be fitted into your day, and it's not too late to start this amazing adventure! The podcast is available on all the major Apps, and on YouTube (with sub-titles): just search "Bible in a Year Fr Mike".
