## Fishing For People

### ***Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. Year A.***

Have you ever been fishing? Did you catch a fish? I've been fishing off a boat, and if you've never tried it, I can tell you that it's a great feeling when you catch one! So what does it take to be good at catching fish? Firstly, you need to have the right equipment. Next, you have to go where there some fish – a river, stream, or perhaps to the sea. Finally, you must learn patience... Sometimes the fish just aren't biting, and you can sit there for a very long time with nothing happening.

One day, Jesus was walking along the seashore when he saw two brothers named Peter and Andrew. Jesus knew that they made their living by fishing, so he called out to them, "Follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" Do you know what they did? They laid down their fishing nets and followed Jesus.

Jesus wants me and you to fish for people too. That means that he wants us to tell others about his love *for us all* - life is definitely better with Jesus in it! 
