Day 1 to 5 of Bible in a Year provides some really interesting commentary about the Early World section of the Bible, and how it helps us understand salvation history. Learn about the Fall of Adam and Eve, Noah's Ark, The Flood and the meaning of the Tower of Babel. It uses a ground-breaking approach developed by renowned Catholic Bible teacher Jeff Cavins, and is highly recommended!
