Children's Liturgy over Easter: Children's Liturgy will be celebrating our Risen Lord on Easter Sunday during the 10.30am Mass; please meet the team by the baptismal font, as usual – or ring the bell for Houlden Hall if you are running a little late. The team will then be having a two week break for the school holidays, returning on Sunday 21st April.

Please note that there will be no refreshments after the 10.30am Sunday Mass on Palm Sunday, because of the ecumenical service at the Cross at 12 noon. There will also be no teas and coffees on Easter Sunday.

Ecumenical Act of Witness at the Cross (Palm Sunday, 2nd April, 12.00 noon): Once again this year, there will be an ecumenical service at the Cross outside Town Hall on Palm Sunday, at 12.00 noon, with the Sheffield City Centre churches all participating. Everyone is very welcome.

Flowers for Easter: The Flower Team welcomes donations both of fresh flowers and money. If you would like to bring fresh flowers, please bring them <u>during Holy Week</u>, <u>but before Holy Saturday</u>. Cash donations towards the Easter Flowers can be placed in an envelope and given to a steward or put in a donation pedestal. Thank you for your support.

Divine Mercy Sunday (7th April), Holy Hour, 2.00–3.00pm: There will be a special Holy Hour for Divine Mercy Sunday on Sunday 7th April, from 2.00–3.00pm. Everyone is welcome!

Cathedral Office Opening Hours: Please note that the Cathedral office will be open from Monday in Holy Week to Maundy Thursday (25th–28th March), but will then be closed until Wednesday 10th April.

Facing the Future, Walking Together: The Diocese is inviting us to reflect, pray, and discuss how our parish "is doing", to inform future decisions about parish structures, churches in the diocese, and allocation of clergy. Extra Confessions at St Marie's Cathedral: During Holy Week, there will be two priests hearing Confessions at St Marie's Cathedral at the normal time of 11.30am–12.15pm on Monday 25th and Tuesday 26th March. On Wednesday 27th March, Confessions will be heard from 4.30–5.15pm, and on Maundy Thursday (28th March), Confessions will be heard from 11.30am–1.30pm. You are warmly encouraged to come to Confession before Easter and receive the Lord's mercy and forgiveness—especially if you have been away from the Sacrament for a while!

Divine Mercy Sunday—novena starts on Good Friday: Divine Mercy Sunday takes place on the 2nd Sunday of Easter (which this year is 7th April), and we are all called to pray a novena of the Divine Mercy Chaplet in preparation of this, starting on Good Friday. The next Baptism Preparation course will be on Saturday 13th April, from 9.30-11.00am in Houlden Hall. Registration forms are available after one of the Masses, from a steward or the Priest, or from the Cathedral office. If you wish your child to be baptised at St Marie's, you will need to attend the preparation programme, so please do fill in and return the registration form.

Mass of the Lord's Supper, Holy Thursday—all volunteers please arrive at 7.15pm: If you have signed up to be one of our volunteers at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, please arrive at the Cathedral at 7.15pm. This is especially important for the Canopy and Candle Carriers, who will definitely need time to practice! Volunteers for the foot washing should arrive in the Cathedral by 7:30pm at the latest.
